
## EDITING SYMBOLS


You have used the incorrect verb tense here. Look at the other words and verb tenses around this verb to help you decide on the correct verb tense. Look for clue words like "since" or "by the time" and time markers to help you decide.



You have used the correct verb tense here, but you have formed it incorrectly. Maybe you forgot the "-ing" on a progressive verb tense or used the simple past after "have" instead of the past participle - or maybe we have an issue with active/passive voice.

I see what you mean here, but this is not the appropriate word to express your idea. Revisit the dictionary or look in a thesaurus to find a better word to express your idea.




= WORD FORM

This sentence is too long. You need to find an appropriate place to add a period, semi-colon or connecting word to make this grammatically correct.




# (5) = COMMA SPLICE
